Proclamation

WHEREAS,

in 2017, the Vietnam War Veterans Recognition Act was signed into law designating March 29 of each year as National Vietnam War

Veterans Day; and

WHEARS,

the Act followed a 2012 presidential proclamation commemorating the 50th anniversary of the Vietnam War from May 28, 2012 through

November 11, 2025 and included five objectives for the

commemoration; and

WHEREAS,

the commemoration serves as an opportunity to thank and honor veterans of the Vietnam War, including personnel who were held as prisoners of war, or listed as missing in action, for their service and sacrifice on behalf of the United States and to thank and honor

the families of the veterans; and

WHEREAS,

the commemoration highlights the service of the Armed Forces during the Vietnam War and the contributions of the federal agencies and governmental and non-governmental organizations that served with, or in support of, the Armed Forces; and

WHEREAS,

the commemoration pays tribute to the contributions made on the home front by the people of the United States during the Vietnam War; and

WHEREAS,

the commemoration highlights the advances in technology, science and medicine related to military research conducted during the Vietnam War; and

WHEREAS,

the commemoration recognizes the contributions and sacrifices made by the allies of the United States during the Vietnam War.

NOW, THEREFORE,

I, John Bel Edwards, Governor of the State of Louisiana, do hereby proclaim Sunday, March 29, 2020 as

NATIONAL VIETNAM WAR VETERANS DAY in the State of Louisiana.
