

## Proclamation

**Whereas**, throughout history, our nation's brave men and women in uniform have risked their lives to protect the interests of our country and defend freedom; and

**Whereas**, American citizens live in freedom because of the offerings and sacrifices made by those who have served, and are currently serving in our Armed Services; and

**Whereas**, more than 58,000 Americans made the ultimate sacrifice in Vietnam, and thousands more returned home after being wounded in combat; and

**Whereas**, many still mourn with uncertainty the missing and unaccounted-for Americans from the Vietnam conflict; and

**Whereas**, our state remembers and honors the heroes whose names are listed on the Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington D.C.; and

**Whereas**, March 29, 1973, was the last day United States servicemen were on the ground in Vietnam; and

**Whereas**, it is fitting to acknowledge our veterans for all they have given, and continue to give in service to our nation;

**Now, Therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor**, do hereby proclaim Thursday, March 29, 2018, as

**"Welcome Home Vietnam Veterans Day"**



in the state of Oklahoma.
