Whereas, We salute our brave Vietnam Veterans who, in service to our Nation and in defense of liberty, fought gallantly against the spread of communism and defended the Vietnamese people; and,

Whereas, We embrace our responsibility to help our Vietnam Veterans and their families heal from the heavy tolls of war. We remember the more than 58,000 men and women whose names are memorialized on a black granite wall in our Nation's Capital for having borne the heaviest cost of war; and,

Whereas, More than 27,000 South Dakotans served valiantly under difficult circumstances during the Vietnam War and 210 made the ultimate sacrifice; and,

Whereas, We also pay tribute to all brave patriots who suffered as prisoners of war, and we stand steadfast in our commitment not to rest until we account for the 1,253 heroes who have not yet returned to American soil; and,

Whereas, The Vietnam War is a story of service members of different backgrounds, races, and creeds who came together to complete a daunting mission. It is a story of Americans from every corner of our Nation who left the warmth of family to serve the country they loved. It is a story of patriots who braved the line of fire, who cast themselves into harm's way to save a friend, who fought hour after hour, day after day to preserve the liberties we hold dear; and,

Whereas, We applaud the South Dakota Department of Veterans Affairs, veterans service organizations, and government entities that have publicly and personally thanked and honored these heroes during the National Commemoration of the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Vietnam War; and,

Whereas, By South Dakota statute, March 30 has been designated as Welcome Home Vietnam Veterans Day, a day to pay tribute to the fallen, the missing, the wounded, the millions who served, and the millions more who awaited their return:
