**Vietnam veterans and their families**, especially on and around **National Vietnam War Veterans Day**, was – and remains – inspirational! More than **1,000 commemorative events** in support

of *March* 29, 2019 brought joy to the faces of an estimated 300,000 attendees. Communities joined together, lauding and encouraging 174,000 Vietnam veterans, most who had never before received their Vietnam Veteran Lapel Pin.

808 broadcasts and news articles highlighting March 29 and Vietnam

veterans reached *335 million* ... 218 million viewers of national broadcasts and 117 million readers of print media. *Presidential* and *Vice Presidential "tweets"* led the way to <u>#VietnamVeteransDay</u> becoming the March 29 #1 "trending topic" on Twitter!

In addition, the <u>Wreath-Laying Ceremony</u> at the <u>Vietnam Veterans Memorial</u> in Washington, D.C. was especially poignant, as the photo (at the right) of our director comforting a Gold Star daughter attests. Also, public service announcements by the Secretary of the <u>Department of Veterans Affairs</u> and each leader of the five <u>Military Services</u>

and the National

resonated around

the world. All told, it was a phenomenal day!
