The National Society Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR) has committed to build on its legacy of remarkable, collective success as Commemorative Partners—10 years; 2,069 chapters; 6,112 events hosted; 361 thousand

Vietnam veterans honored—by collaborating with us to bestow this *Honorary Partner* distinction on all **Vietnam Veterans of America** (VVA) organizations. DAR State Regents are coordinating the efforts of their respective chapters to arrange ceremonies for each of the 47 VVA state councils and 601 chapters within our 50 states and the District of Columbia.

During these public ceremonies, DAR chapter members will present a <u>Commemorative Flag</u> and <u>Honorary Partner</u> certificate to each VVA entity. In addition, any Vietnam veteran who has yet to receive a <u>Vietnam Veteran Lapel Pin</u> (VVLP) will be honored with a personal presentation of that lapel pin. Finally, any surviving spouse of a late Vietnam veteran attending one of these ceremonies will receive their veteran's VVLP, along with a <u>Surviving Spouse Lapel Pin</u>. All will receive a warm <u>Welcome</u> <u>Home!</u> along with the humble thanks of a grateful Nation. Of note, next week the <u>John James Audubon Chapter</u> (DAR) will host the very first VVA chapter ceremony for Chapter 852 in Baton Rouge, LA!
