First, on January 13, a very special <u>A Celebration of Character</u> & Courage ceremony was held at the Washington National Cathedral alongside the Air & Space Forces Association, with other contributing Commemorative Partners. This ceremony honored the service, courage and legacy of Vietnam veterans, Gold Star Families, and included a renewal of

In addition, a reception followed the ceremony where in total, *130 Vietnam veterans* were thanked and honored! For those unable to attend
